- 300 Research PGs


- 7 Schools

Session 2006-2007...

- Only 49 Class Reps trained in 2006/07
- Link to SA and University unclear
- Class Rep system fragmented between schools each school different
- New cohort every year
- Class Reps 'fell off the radar' in Semester B



Session 2007 - 2008...

- 111 Class Rep trained
- Communications between SA & Class Reps increased
- A focus required for Semester B
- The first incarnation of Caledonian Conference created for Semester B...



Session 2008 - 2009...

- 140 Class Rep trained.
- Further and improved communications between SA & Class Reps increased.
- Class Rep numbers have grown from 364 to 461 registered.
- Student Summit introduced.
- Caledonian Conference delivered in Semester B.






