School President Remit

The role and remit of your School President and Vice-Presidents are as follows:

- Ensure that any problems or issues that cannot be resolved promptly at the discipline level are brought to the attention of School Board.
- Help inform the School decision and policy making process.
- Improve the effectiveness and engagement in quality assurance.
- Assist in fostering a sense of School identity.
- Sit on the Student Representative Council (SRC), providing a voice for the School at the Highest level of student representation.
- Liaise regularly with the DUSA Deputy President who has the lead role in the DUSA Executive on representation issues and the relevant DUSA Sabbatical Officer who has responsibility for the School's College.
- Work with the School Secretary to keep up to date with what is currently happening at School level.
- Communicate regularly with Class Reps and students within their School to obtain information on current issues and to raise awareness of the importance of effective student representation.
